How To Use Your Course

1. **Rip through the shipping envelop**, grab your DVDs and the Jam Tracks CD and put everything in front of you.
2. *Grab your guitar!* (And get in tune).
3. Open up the bonus “**Mastering Pentatonic & Blues Scales**” **book** that was emailed to you when you placed your order. Can find the email? Then submit a support ticket [here](#).
4. Play through **all five movable patterns** of the pentatonic scale. (Hint: it will be really good if you take 15 minutes and *memorize* these patterns. But don't sweat it. It's not absolutely necessary).
5. Open up the 50 Must-Know Blues Licks **book** that came with your course. (Print it out if you want).
6. Pop in the Jam Tracks CD and **listen to all 50 licks**. Pick out the ones you like best. Make a list of those licks.
7. Pop in the “50 Must-Know Licks DVD” and **jump to the section that has your favorite licks**. Watch and learn! (Note: it's not necessary that you learn all the licks in order, but it wouldn't be a bad idea because they get more difficult as you go along).
8. Pop in the “**Creating Blues Solos**” **DVD**. Here you'll learn how to take the licks you've learned and play them over the backing tracks. (I teach you how to transpose the licks so they'll match the jam tracks).
9. **Pick out your favorite licks**. Chose a jam track that you like. Transpose the licks to the appropriate key. Crank out a soul-stirring solo!
10. Take the licks you've learned and try to change them up to create your own. **Practice improvising** over the jam tracks with the new licks and scale patterns you've learned. **Have fun!**
